SCDP Program Purpose

- To support children who require extra supports to fully participate in community child care settings:
 - Supporting child development
 - Addressing child care needs of working/student parents





Roadblocks to Change

Roadblocks	Strategy
Clinging to status quo	Increase urgency – people realize change is necessary
Lack or weak guiding coalition	Build the guiding team
Inefficient and insufficient communication	Relate change to the needs of clients – how can we improve services
Failing to create short term wins	Create early wins – build momentum
Fatigue or declaring victory too soon	Change is incremental – be patient – new behaviour starts to win people over and creates change
